WHEREAS, plans are prepared for the resurfacing of Old Jacksonville Road (CH 8) from Bradfordton Road (CH 17) to Farmingdale Road (CH 15) designated as 06-00064-05-RS; and,

WHEREAS, plans are prepared for the resurfacing of Old Jacksonville Road (CH 8) from Farmingdale Road (CH 15) to Waverly Road (CH 10) designated as 06-00078-04-RS; and,

WHEREAS, Sangamon County plans to use Truck Access Route Program Funds and Federal Funds to pay for a portion of the construction costs; and,

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of construction for the two sections are \$2,010,000.00 and \$2,400,000.00 respectively; and,

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois, by its General Assembly, has enacted "The Illinois Vehicle Code"; and

WHEREAS, 625 ILCS 5/1-126.1 provides that local authorities may designate Class II or Class III highways within their jurisdiction, and in accordance with 625 ILCS 5/15-111(f), weight limitations shall be designated by appropriate signs placed on such highways; and

WHEREAS, Sangamon County is desirous of providing a truck route on the above mentioned routes for the purpose of accommodating a load limit of 80,000 pounds.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Board of Sangamon County at its **Regular Reconvened Adjourned September Session**, assembled this 12th day of January, A.D., 2010, that the portions of Old Jacksonville Road (CH 8) from Bradfordton Road (CH 17) to Farmingdale Road (CH 15) and from Farmingdale Road (CH 15) to Waverly Road (CH 10) be designated as a Class III Truck Routes upon the completion of the construction of Section 06-00064-05-RS and Section 06-00078-04-RS.
