WHEREAS, the Glock 22 pistols currently deployed by the Sangamon County Sheriff's Office are over ten years old and nearing the end of their operational life; and,

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office has an inventory of surplus firearms and ammunition; and,

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Sheriff's Office has solicited public bids on a plan to surplus both firearms and ammunition in exchange for replacement of eighty-three Glock 22 pistols; and,

WHEREAS, the Ray O'Herron Company, Inc. was selected as the vendor at the 20 April 2010 Jail Committee, with a bid that provides new Glock firearms at no additional cost to the County ,

NOW THEREFORE BE RESOLVED, by the County Board of Sangamon County at its Regular Reconvened Adjourned September Session assembled this 11<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2010 that the Sangamon County Sheriff's Office is hereby authorized to accept the bid of Ray O'Herron Company, Inc., and to surplus both weapons and ammunition and replace current sidearms.
