**SANGAMON COUNTY ELECTION OFFICE  
FREEDOM OF INFORMATION**

**Main Office:** Sangamon County Election Office is located in the Sangamon County Complex, Room 105, 200 South 9<sup>th</sup> Street, Springfield, IL 62701.

**Other Locations:** There are no separate offices in other locations.

**Purpose:** The County Clerk is the chief Election Authority administering elections throughout Sangamon County. The County Clerk is responsible for providing a variety of services to the voters including; voter registration and outreach programs; absentee, early and grace period voting; recruitment, training and scheduling of election judges; and election night tabulation of results. Our office also provides candidates, political parties, media, local units of government and the general public with election information such as; precinct lists, maps of political subdivisions, pollwatcher credentials and election results.

**Freedom of Information (FOI) Officer:** Sangamon County Election's Freedom of Information Officer is Stacey Kern, Director of Elections, located in the Sangamon County Complex, Room 105, 200 S. 9<sup>th</sup> Street, Springfield, IL 62701. Phone (217) 753-6740. The alternate FOI Officer is Kelley Bergae, Director of Vital Records, Room 101, 200 S. 9<sup>th</sup> Street, Springfield, IL 62701. Phone (217) 753-6705.

**FOI Procedures:** Interested parties can request information in any way convenient to them. In-person and mailed requests should be made to the Election Office. It is preferred that requests be made in writing and a simple form is available by calling the Election Office at (217) 753-6740. Requests may also be faxed to (217) 753-6739.

**Budget:** Sangamon County Election's budget for the current fiscal year is \$1,402,946.

**Employees:** Sangamon County Election Office currently has 7 full-time employees and 2 part-time employees.

**Advisory Boards:** The Sangamon County Election Office's budget is governed by the 29 member Sangamon County Board who are elected. The Election Office reports monthly to the bi-partisan Election Oversight Committee composed of the following members of the County Board; Joel Tjelmeland, Jr. (Chairman), Jennifer Dillman (Vice Chairman), Clyde Bunch, Andy Goleman, Rosemarie Long and Sam Snell.
