

RESOLUTION NO. 17-1

WHEREAS, the proliferation of internet sales of products has created a need to license and regulate the internet sale of alcoholic beverages;

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Code does not currently provide for a license regulating the sale of alcoholic beverages through an internet website;

WHEREAS, the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of Sangamon County would best be served by creation of a license regulating the internet sale of alcoholic beverages;

WHEREAS, amendment of the Sangamon County Liquor Code, Chapter 5.04 Sangamon County Ordinances is necessary to regulate this activity.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Sangamon County Board in session this 10th day of May, 2005, A.D. that the Sangamon County Liquor Code be amended as provided for in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

17(b) "Internet website" means a site location on the Internet.

14. IIS – Internet Sales. An Internet Sales License shall entitle the license holder to sell beer and wine only, in the original package, during the hours prescribed in Section 5.04.200(D) through an internet website and shall not authorize consumption on the licensed premises, nor shall it authorize direct to the public sale of packaged beer and wine upon the licensed premises.

5.04.200(D) Persons licensed to sell beer/wine under this chapter as a Class 1E licensee, Class IWW licensee and Class IIS shall not permit such beer/wine to be sold between the hours of 1 a.m. and 7 a.m. Monday through Saturday; and between 1 a.m. and 12 p.m. on Sunday.
