

A RESOLUTION TO PROCURE OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT RADIOS

WHEREAS, Sangamon County Office of Emergency Management (OEM) owns 4 radio base stations which will become obsolete under FCC narrowbanding requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Terrorism Task Force has offered OEM \$24,000 toward the total purchase price of replacing these 4 radios through a grant with the conditions that such funds be expended by June 30, 2011, and that purchase of the radio base stations follow local purchasing guidelines; and

WHEREAS, a consultant assisting OEM with meeting FCC narrowbanding requirements wrote specifications for the radio base stations and WirelessUSA, the local Motorola radio shop, bid a unit price of \$15,432 per radio on the Motorola 125 watt Quantar VHF model or a total of \$61,728 for 4 conforming radio base stations when solicited by OEM; and

WHEREAS, Sangamon County Emergency Telephone System Board has authorized up to \$37,728 in matching funds toward a total purchase price for 4 radio base stations not exceeding \$61,728; and

WHEREAS, in the last half of May 2011, Motorola 125 watt Quantar VHF radios became available for purchase through the Illinois Joint Purchasing Program with a per unit price of \$13,869 or a total of \$55,476 for 4 radio base stations as specified when procured directly from Motorola Solutions; and

WHEREAS, local purchasing guidelines provide for procurement through the Illinois Joint Purchasing Program and OEM should procure these 4 radio base stations using this program; and

WHEREAS, purchase from Motorola Solutions through the Illinois Joint Purchasing Program requires the Director of OEM to execute a Letter of Intent to Purchase to initiate the procurement process;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Members of the Sangamon County Board, in session this 14th day of June, 2011, that the Director of OEM should procure 4 Motorola 125 watt Quantar VHF radio base stations at a cost not to exceed \$55,476 and execute a Letter of Intent to Purchase to initiate the procurement process with Motorola Solutions.
