WHEREAS, County policies and procedures require both the assigned oversight committee and the Finance Committee to approve all requests to apply for grants from Federal and State agencies, as well as grants from all other entities; and,

WHEREAS, County policies and procedures require that the acceptance of grants of \$30,000 or more must be approved by the full County Board;

WHEREAS, the Department of Community Resources wishes to apply for and accept an a grant from the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO) for the 2019 LIHEAP program in the amount of approximately \$622,344; and

WHEREAS, this grant will allow Community Resources to provide gas and electric utility assistance for income-eligible households; and

WHEREAS, as documented by the approval of this resolution, Community Resource Committee and the Finance Committee have approved the Community Resources Department's request to apply for the 2019 LIHEAP grant and the committees recommend that the County Board approve the acceptance of this grant, if awarded by DCEO.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sangamon County Board, in session this 11th day of December, 2018, approves the acceptance of the 2019 LIHEAP grant, which is detailed above, if the grant is awarded to the County by DCEO. The County Administrator is authorized to sign required grant documents to execute the agreement for this grant.

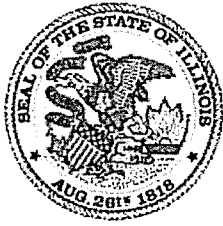

RE: Release of 2019 HHS LIHEAP Grant Funding

PURPOSE: To notify Local Administering Agencies (LAAs) of the release of 2019 HHS LIHEAP funding.

BACKGROUND: Based on the anticipated release of 2019 LIHEAP funds from HHS, the Department will release additional LIHEAP funding to LAAs for continued 2019 LIHEAP activities.

The 2019 LIHEAP HHS funding will be issued through the following grant to local agencies:

2019 HHS LIHEAP Grants - OCA will issue new 2019 HHS LIHEAP grants with a start date of 10/1/18 and an end date of 6/30/19. These 2019 HHS LIHEAP grants (19-2240XX) will provide funding for the continuation of the 2019 Heating Program and start of the 2019 Heating Program next fall. This allocation will provide a total of \$40,000,000 in initial LIHEAP funding to LAAs, while providing a reserve for Lack of Funds if necessary during this heating season as well as start up funding for the 2020 program.

Note: The issuance of the 2019 HHS LIHEAP grants is contingent upon the issuance of the 2019 LIHEAP grant award from HHS.
