**A RESOLUTION APPROVING
THE DESIGNATION OF
THE GEORGE POWER COURTHOUSE AT THE HISTORIC GEORGE POWER FARM
AS A SANGAMON COUNTY HISTORIC SITE**

WHEREAS, Sangamon County Historic Preservation Commission has recommended the George Power Courthouse at the Historic George Power Farm for designation as a Sangamon County Historic Landmark and applied for same, and

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Historic Preservation Commission has determined that the site meets the criteria for landmark designation and has held a public hearing on same, and

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Historic Preservation Commission following careful and thoughtful consideration recommends to the Sangamon County Board that the George Power Courthouse at the Historic George Power Farm be designated a Sangamon County Historic Landmark.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1: The George Power Courthouse at the Historic George Power Farm is hereby designated a Sangamon County Historic Landmark by the Board of Sangamon County, Illinois.

Section 2: The Chairman of the Sangamon County Board is authorized to sign and the County Clerk to attest approval of this resolution for and in the name of Sangamon County, Illinois.

Section 3: The resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
