WHEREAS, Sangamon County Historic Preservation Commission member Jerome Jacobson has recommended the Sangamon Ordnance Plant Water Tower for designation as a Sangamon County Historic Landmark and applied for same, and

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Historic Preservation Commission has determined that the site meets the criteria for landmark designation and has held a public hearing on same, and

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Historic Preservation Commission following careful and thoughtful consideration recommends to the Sangamon County Board that the Sangamon Ordnance Plant Water Tower be designated a Sangamon County Historic Landmark.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS:
