EXHIBIT A

5.04.020 – Definitions

“BASSET” means The Beverage Alcohol Sellers and Servers Education and Training (BASSET) program is the state of Illinois' seller/server training program. The program is an educational and training tool to sellers/servers of alcoholic beverages to serve responsibly and stay within the law. The BASSET Certification Program serves as a preventive measure to discourage over consumption and keep drunk drivers off the roads.

5.04.405 – Basset Requirements

(a) For licenses on or after (June 30, 2017) and all original or renewal applications for a class (1AA, 2AA, 3AA, 1BB, 1PC, 1E, 1FF, 1RR, 1WW & 1K) liquor licenses shall be accompanied with proof of completion of a State certified Beverage Alcohol Sellers and Servers Education and Training (BASSET) program for all persons who sell or serve alcoholic beverages, all management personnel working on premises, and anyone whose job description entails the checking of identification for the purchases of alcoholic beverages, pursuant to that license.

(b) After (June 30, 2017), any new owner, manager, employee, or agent requiring BASSET training, shall within ninety(90) days from the beginning of their employment with that licensee, complete an ILCC BASSET approved seller/server training program and shall until completion of the BASSET program work under the supervision of a person who has completed BASSET training.
