

Resolution 9-1

WHEREAS, Sangamon County has a population of less than 3,000,000 inhabitants, operates under the township form of government, and is thereby required, pursuant to Section 2-3002 of the Counties Code (55 ILCS 5/2-3002), to reapportion its county every ten years so that each member of the county board represents a substantially equal number of inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, as part of the reapportionment process, Section 2-3002 requires the County Board to determine the size of the county board to be elected and determine whether board members shall be elected at large from the county or by county board districts; and

WHEREAS, as part of the reapportionment process, Section 2-3003(1) of the Counties Code provides that if the County Board determines that members be elected by districts, it shall develop an apportionment plan, specify the number of districts and the number of board members to be elected from each district, and specify whether voters will have cumulative voting rights in multi-member districts.

WHEREAS, Section 2-3004 of the Counties Code provides that if the County Board does not complete its reapportionment plan by November 17, 2021, the County Clerk is to form a commission to perform the task; and

WHEREAS, the County Board desires to complete the reapportionment process itself in accordance with all applicable provisions of the Counties Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Members of the Board of Sangamon County, Illinois, in session this **10th day of August 2021**, as authorized by the reapportionment provisions of the Counties Code, hereby adopt the following:

1: That the County Board to be elected under the reapportionment shall consist of twenty-nine members, which number does not exceed the size of the County Board on October 2, 1969; and

2: That Sangamon County be divided into twenty-nine county board districts to be numbered from 1 through 29, and that there be one county board member elected from each district; and

3: A Sangamon County Board reapportionment plan map determining twenty-nine county board districts in compliance with the requirements of 55 ILCS 5/2-3003 be presented to the Board for its consideration on or before November 17, 2021.
