

RESOLUTION 1-1

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Board Chairman, through a Proclamation of Sangamon County Disaster (hereinafter the “Proclamation”) executed by him and which was effective and filed with the Sangamon County Clerk on March 16, 2020, proclaimed that a disaster existed in Sangamon County as a result of the COVID-19 virus; and

WHEREAS, the Proclamation will expire on March 23, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the disaster identified in the Proclamation, as well as the need to address the disaster as set forth in the Proclamation, both continue to exist; and

WHEREAS, Section 11(a) of the Illinois Emergency Management Act, 20 ILCS 11(a), and Section 2.25.080 of the Sangamon County Code, both require the consent of the County Board to continue the disaster declaration beyond March 23, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Members of the Board of Sangamon County, Illinois, in session this 23rd day of March, 2020, that the March 16, 2020, Proclamation of Sangamon County Disaster shall be continued until this Board, via a duly enacted resolution, declares that the need to address the disaster as allowed by the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act has ended. It is further directed that this Resolution continuing the Proclamation shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.


