Note: Independent and New Parties 1st day to circulate is March 24th and filing period is June 15th - June 22nd.
WHAT TO FILE: Candidates must file the following papers, except as noted: Statement of Candidacy, Loyalty Oath (optional), Receipt for filing a Statement of Economic Interest (excluding Precinct Committeemen), and Nominating Petition sheets containing a sufficient number of original signatures.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

PLEASE NOTE: Candidates are strongly advised to obtain legal counsel regarding their legal qualifications for office, the proper method for completing the petition forms with respect to the office, the minimum and maximum number of signatures required and the qualifications of the signers and circulators, and other filing requirements.
